



Faith Lutheran Church Annual Food Donation

For many years, Faith Lutheran Church in New Providence has brought down hundreds of boxes of donated food on the Saturday after Thanksgiving to help stock our Pantry. We are so grateful to them and to all of the groups and individuals who donate food and \$\$ to help us in our mission.



Church members and volunteers set up their rolling ramp to quickly unload the truck. 600+ boxes of food, paper goods, cleaning supplies, personal care items come off the truck quickly and are stacked and then sorted by other volunteers.



Tables are ready, then loaded with boxes to be sorted by volunteers. These empty shelves that were waiting for this special delivery were full by the end of the day. Donations by other groups helped fill other shelves.



Food for Thought Donation

A very fine group of volunteers from the Scotch Plains area, Food for Thought brings us boxes filled with everything needed for 25 Thanksgiving dinners. They even give us their leftovers!

Tables are set up with a Partner Agency's name, a list of food items based on size of family (above, with Frosty assisting), bags pre-labeled with clients' names. All the food items are placed down the center of the room in the same order as the above list, making it easier for the volunteers to find items and fill their bags. Need more? We just go to the Pantry shelves.

We are a group of volunteers from Plainfield and the surrounding area who belong to a tax exempt, 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation in existence since 1971. We operate three days each week throughout the year, preparing and distributing grocery food orders to an average of thirty to thirty-five families in need each week.

Our primary function is to maintain the food pantry. Our volunteers pack and deliver grocery food orders to clients who have been referred to us by local social service agencies. Most of these agencies are listed on our website [Partners page](#).

Using a referral system helps us better manage our resources. These agencies vet the client to help assure that our limited resources are given to those truly in need. We also prepare special food orders for 160 families at Easter, Thanksgiving, and at Christmas.

The generosity of our donors helps us prepare these holiday meals and bags of food each week for those in need of emergency food assistance. You are all "Stars for Star Fish!"

The Food We Provide To Those In Need—Amounts Vary Based on Family Size

- 1 Package of frozen meat
- 1 Loaf of bread
- 1 lb of Pasta
- 1 Pasta Sauce
- 4 Cans Soup
- 2 Macaroni and Cheese
- 1 Small bag of tea bags
- 1 Jar Peanut Butter
- 1 Jar Jelly
- 1 Can of Fruit or Jar of Applesauce
- 4 Cans Vegetables
- 2 Can of Tuna
- 4 Cans of Beans
- 1/2 Dozen Eggs
- 2 box of cereal (or 4 Instant Breakfast Cereal envelopes for single persons)
- 1 dry or shelf-stable milk
- 1 Paper goods, 1 cleaning product, and 1 personal care item



You can donate any of these items at any time. Contact us and we'll even arrange to pick it up!
